In 1949, the University of Maryland Global Campus (UMGC) was the only pioneering institution to send seven professors to teach military students in postwar Germany. This deep–rooted tradition of serving the military in war and peace continues to this day.

This year, we are proud to celebrate our 73rd year of delivering higher education overseas to U.S. military servicemembers and their families, exemplified through the incredible achievements of our students.



CELEBRATING 73 YEARS OVERSEAS

UMGC was founded in 1947 as the College of Special and Continuation Studies, a branch of the University of Maryland's College of Education, with locations in College Park and around the state. In 1949, UMGC became the first university to send faculty overseas to educate active-duty military personnel in Europe. What started off as a noble experiment, with seven professors in six cities in Germany, has turned into a globally-recognized, award-winning institution that includes graduates from all 50 U.S. states, the District of Columbia, and over 20 countries and territories worldwide.

UMGC Europe is proud to be in a continued partnership with the U.S. government and the state of Maryland to provide quality education to over 12,000 students annually in 16 countries and 50+ locations in Europe, the Middle East, and North Africa. We are wherever the military is, whether permanently stationed or deployed. Times have changed since those first classes in war-torn buildings 73 years ago. Now we deliver courses both on-site and online using cutting-edge technology, tailored class schedules for individual military units, and innovative live streaming formats at many locations.





More than one million servicemembers have taken UMGC courses. This long relationship has made the university particularly sensitive to the needs of the military community and has prepared UMGC to handle key details, including veterans benefits and the transfer of credit earned in military specialty schools. By proving that high standards of excellence can be maintained in nontraditional settings, UMGC has established itself as an integral part of military life.

Students graduating from UMGC Europe in the Class of 2022 have earned 440 associate degrees, 609 bachelor's degrees, and 144 master's degrees. Graduates represent U.S. military communities across the European, Central, and Africa Commands, with many having served or currently serving in war zones. Worldwide nearly 14,000 graduates will have earned a UMGC degree this year.

Today, UMGC remains committed to the same unifying mission, offering a high-quality education that is affordable and accessible, while meeting critical workforce needs and accommodating the busy lifestyles of adults in the 21st century and the modern U.S. Armed Forces.

We are honored to celebrate 73 years of providing quality education to extraordinary students overseas, including those here today who have achieved an important educational milestone in their lives.



GREGORY W. FOWLER PRESIDENT UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND

GLOBAL CAMPUS

Gregory W. Fowler, PhD, seventh president of University of Maryland Global Campus, is a nationally recognized scholar and leader in developing innovative learning models and experiences for adult and nontraditional populations. He served on the leadership teams that built what are now the two largest universities in America—both of which serve nontraditional students in nontraditional ways.

Most recently, Fowler served as president of Southern New Hampshire University (SNHU) Global Campus and before that as SNHU's chief academic officer and vice president for academic affairs for its College of Online and Continuing Education. There, he led efforts to develop competency-based online and hybrid programs that respond to the rapidly changing demands of the workforce and global communities.

Earlier, Fowler held senior-level academic and administrative positions at Western Governors University (WGU), serving as associate provost and dean of liberal arts, overseeing development of new competency-based degree programs and—as director of Education Without Boundaries—launching a new student orientation program that exponentially increased student persistence.

Fowler was raised in Albany, Georgia, one of eight children in a family of modest means. He realized early on the power of education to transform lives and communities. Working at the Six Flags Over Georgia theme park as a teenager taught him the importance of teamwork to organizational success and helped shape his management style.

After completing undergraduate studies at Morehouse College—including two years as a Charles A. Dana Scholar at Duke UniversityFowler began his career at the National Endowment for the Humanities (NEH) in Washington, D.C., helping underserved populations access funds and resources to support their communities and amplify their voices.

While in the Washington, D.C., area, he earned a master's degree in English from George Mason University, then accepted a position as lecturer and, later, as assistant professor of literature and American studies at Penn State University–Erie while he pursued his doctorate in English/American studies from the State University of New York (SUNY) at Buffalo.

While at Penn State, Fowler also received the first of two Fulbright awards to Germany and Belgium, where he would collaborate with students, faculty, and lawmakers on the future of the European Union and impact of the Bologna Accords. He also taught at the John F. Kennedy Institute for North American Studies at *Freie Universität–Berlin*.

Fowler served as commissioner and board member of the New England Commission of Higher Education (NECHE), and in that role, co-chaired the team responsible for the future of post-pandemic remote learning experiences for colleges and universities.

He currently serves on the Presidents Forum, the Board of Directors of the National Cryptologic Foundation, the Board of Trustees of the Consortium of Universities of the Washington Metropolitan Area, and the UPCEA Council for Chief Online Learning Officers.

Fowler has been profiled in the *Washington Post* and named to the *Maryland Daily Record's* Power 30 Higher Education list for 2021. He is coauthor of *Anticipating and Managing Precipitous College Closures* (New America, 2020), and contributed to *Five Themes for Centering Student Equity*, published in 2020 by the Sorenson Impact Center at the University of Utah.

He has been a MAPS (Modeling, Analyzing, Prototyping, and Sharing) scholar with the Sorenson and Gates Foundations and an Aspen Institute scholar for the Postsecondary Success for Parents Initiative.

In addition to degrees from Morehouse College, George Mason University, and SUNY–Buffalo, Fowler holds an MBA from Western Governors University and has completed programs in higher education administration and executive leadership and negotiation from the Harvard University Graduate School of Education and Business School, respectively.

UMGC LEADERSHIP



TONY K. CHO VICE PRESIDENT AND DIRECTOR

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS EUROPE Mr. Tony K. Cho is the vice president and director of UMGC Europe. Emphasizing service to students, growth, and leadership, he leads the administrative and academic operations for faculty and staff at headquarters and in 16 countries across Europe, the Middle East, and Africa. He joined the team in Europe in 2017 from UMGC Asia, where he had served as the associate vice president and deputy director.

Cho retired as a colonel after 26 years of service in the United States Army as both a combat arms and foreign area officer. His last assignment was as the Northeast Asia policy division chief for the U.S. Joint Chiefs of Staff at the Pentagon, working as the primary advisor to the Chairman on issues related to North Korea, South Korea, Japan, and Guam. This followed a variety of command and staff positions throughout the Middle East, Asia, South Asia, and Europe, including serving as Senior Army Fellow and political-military affairs officer at the State Department.

Cho's combat tours include Operation Desert Storm as an infantry platoon leader, and Operation Enduring Freedom as the director of operations in Pakistan. His military awards include the coveted Combat Infantryman's Badge and the Ranger Tab.

Prior to joining the Army, Cho was an aeronautical engineer with Lockheed Martin Corporation Space Systems, leading a team of engineers in designing the flight control systems for the Navy's submarinelaunched Trident II ballistic missile. He also worked on advanced fighter programs at the NASA Dryden Flight Research Center.

Cho received a BS in Aeronautical and Astronautical Engineering from the University of Illinois. He also holds an MS in Mechanical Engineering from Stanford University; an MA in East Asian Studies and an MPA from Harvard University; and an MA in National Security Studies from the U.S. Army War College.



PATRICIA COOPERSMITH

ASSOCIATE VICE PRESIDENT AND DEPUTY DIRECTOR

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS EUROPE Ms. Patricia A. Coopersmith has served as the associate vice president and deputy director of UMGC Europe since November 2016, responsible for headquarters departments and for a wide variety of policies and processes across the division.

She has over 30 years of business and advisory experience in academic, government, and corporate environments. Prior to UMGC, Coopersmith served at the DoD National Defense University (NDU) in Washington, D.C., as the director of Outreach, International Relations, and Academic Partnerships. There, she was responsible for NDU's iCollege Academic Partnership Program, growing it from eight university partners to more than forty. UMGC was the first NDU partner.

She obtained professional in human resources (PHR) certification, was awarded a Meritorious Award for Excellence in Information Technology from the Armed Forces Communications and Electronics Association (AFCEA), and was presented with the Joint Civilian Service Achievement Award for exceptionally meritorious service from the U.S. Department of Defense.

Coopersmith has worked extensively with the Department of Defense and other federal government agencies, as well as with international Defense Ministries in Europe and in Asia. She has taught as an adjunct professor at NDU and at the University of Mary Washington. Prior to her tenure at NDU, she served as a Business Process Reengineering (BPR) management consultant for IBM and for PricewaterhouseCoopers and as an industrial engineer for Westinghouse Corporation.

Her education includes an MBA from Augusta University and a BS in Industrial Engineering from Penn State University.

ANDREW D. BOONE ASSOCIATE VICE PRESIDENT AND ASSOCIATE DEAN ACADEMIC AFFAIRS

UNIVERSITY OF MARYLAND GLOBAL CAMPUS EUROPE Dr. Andrew D. Boone was appointed associate vice provost for UMGC Europe Academic Affairs in 2017, and is now associate vice president and associate dean. As senior academic officer, he provides leadership for all undergraduate and graduate programs in Europe. His primary goal is to ensure students receive quality learning experiences that provide them with the knowledge, skills, and abilities required to be competent professionals and citizens. Passionate about excellence in teaching, he also directs the management of the faculty corps who teach at over 50 sites across Europe and the Middle East.

His thoughtful leadership has shaped the academic achievements of thousands of students who have attended UMGC overseas. Beginning his career with the university in 1992, Boone taught throughout Germany and at the international campus in Schwäbisch Gmünd. Further, he held a number of administrative roles including an appointment as the department chair for business and economics.

In 2002, Boone transferred to UMGC Asia, where he taught in Korea, Iwakuni, and Tokyo. During his 15 year tenure in Asia, Boone assumed a variety of leadership roles such as academic director for business, management, and economics; area director for Korea; and two appointments as associate dean.

Boone's classroom acumen is second to none, having led statistics, math, economics, and business courses on two continents for the better part of three decades with UMGC. In addition, he has taught at Houston Community College, the University of Houston, and the University of North Carolina, Wilmington.

Boone holds a BS in Economics from the University of Arizona. Additionally, he earned an MS and a PhD in Economics from the University of Houston.

STANLEY J. DRAZEK TEACHING EXCELLENCE AWARD

Dr. Stanley J. Drazek (1918–96) joined University of Maryland Global Campus in 1948, one year after its founding. During more than 30 years at UMGC, he served successively as faculty member, director of the Baltimore division, dean, and chancellor.



One of Dr. Drazek's lifelong interests was excellence in teaching. He worked hard to recruit exceptional faculty for UMGC, and he established programs to help teachers reach their full potential in the classroom. Because Dr. Drazek viewed teaching excellence as one of the university's core values, it is fitting that UMGC's Teaching Excellence Award is named in his honor.

Each year, this award is bestowed on faculty members who have been nominated by their students for their distinguished teaching. Two faculty members are being recognized today as this year's UMGC Europe recipients of the Stanley J. Drazek Teaching Excellence Award.

MICHAEL J. MULVEY

COLLEGIATE ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR Dr. Michael J. Mulvey hears two responses to his courses frequently: "why am I just learning about this now?" and "this course changed my life." Because he can talk to military students and civilians about the past and how it relates to our everyday lives, he describes teaching as the best job in Europe. For Mulvey, welltaught history is an active process which has everything to do with asking questions rather than memorizing boring facts and dates. His goal is for students to trust their abilities and take control of their own learning. "Dr. Mulvey is by far the most compassionate, caring, and knowledgeable professor I have had," wrote one student. "He has a way of connecting with and including all students who have ever had the privilege of taking one of his classes."

Mulvey encourages students to practice the craft of historians by balancing evidence interpretation, narrative thinking, and creative communication. He helps them identify digitized primary sources and then provides workshops on the hardest part of history writing! To practice active history, he encourages serious play and organizes activities that piece together human stories. For example, in his Roman Republic course, students role play and game play about the late-Roman Republic. Each student becomes a different Roman senator who has confronted difficult political and military choices. In his World War I class, students conduct research about the Great War and translate this into a hypothetical film proposal. Students learn that a sensitivity to the past's paradoxes inspires hope through human choice, thereby reminding them that they are called to be great.

Mulvey received a PhD in History from the University of North Carolina at Chapel Hill with a focus on modern European, African, and global history. He has received numerous competitive research grants and published in peer-review journals. Mulvey is grateful for all he learns from students and their perspectives on the past, present, and future. Outside the classroom, he enjoys visiting historical sites across Europe with family, colleagues, and students.



LASHAWN THOMPSON

COLLEGIATE ASSOCIATE PROFESSOR "She has a way of teaching that makes you feel like you are just chatting with a friend, but you learn so much" is how one student described their experience of Dr. LaShawn Thompson and her teaching style. "Not only did she share her vast knowledge in psychology, but her love for her field was also deep and infectious, which made it a pleasure being in her class" wrote another.

Engaging students in lectures that are "extremely fun" while putting "life into learning," she has taught courses in psychology and its' application, as well as instructing in diversity awareness and multicultural issues. In her courses, students gain knowledge that can be applied to any area of continued learning and are able to apply those learned principles to their own lives, making them "a better person" after instruction. She believes in "learnerization" and not memorization, a word invented to emphasize to students the value of learning concepts over memorizing them.

Thompson is committed to the idea that learning is a collaborative and reflective process that should be respected by all participants. In this type of learning, teachers establish rapport with students, attain respect, and maintain supportive environments where students' critical thinking skills can be challenged and nurtured.

Believing her responsibility as an educator reaches far beyond the classroom, Thompson is dedicated to assisting students in accomplishing not only academic goals but also personal and career-oriented goals as well.

Thompson is a nationally recognized Dr. Ronald E. McNair Post Baccalaureate Scholar and in 2011, earned her PhD in Psychology from the University of Southern Mississippi. She is a licensed therapist and is certified by the National Board of Certified Counselors. Joining UMGC Europe in 2019, she has past experience in the areas of teaching, mentoring, counseling, program developing, public speaking, and supervision of clinical services.

The William C. Bentley Memorial Award was established in 1983 and is presented each year in honor of Colonel William C. 

HONORS CANDIDATES

ACADEMIC HONORS for excellence in scholarship are determined from the cumulative grade point averages of undergraduate baccalaureate students who have completed 30 or more credits with University of Maryland Global Campus. Students may earn the distinctions of *cum laude, magna cum laude,* and *summa cum laude,* to signify graduation with honor, high honor, and highest honor, respectively. Sometimes called graduation honors, these traditional academic designations are awarded at the time a baccalaureate degree is conferred.

The distinction of *cum laude* honors is conferred on those students with a cumulative grade point average of 3.8 to 3.9, *magna cum laude* is conferred on those students with a grade point average of 3.901 to 3.999, and *summa cum laude* is conferred on those students with a grade point average of 4.0.

Students who have earned these honors wear cords as part of their academic regalia for the commencement ceremony: white cords indicate *cum laude* honors, blue cords indicate *magna cum laude*, and gold cords indicate *summa cum laude*.

ACADEMIC DRESS

THE GOWNS worn by participants in today's procession indicate which academic degrees they hold. At the bachelor's level and above, the gown is usually black, but some universities use colored gowns. At UMGC, doctoral candidates wear red gowns; master's and bachelor's candidates wear black, and associate degree candidates wear the traditional light-gray gown.

The style of sleeve connotes the level of achievement: straight-bottomed sleeves indicate the associate and bachelor's degree; longer, dangling sleeves, the master's degree; and fuller, round sleeves the doctorate.

The gown worn by those who have earned a doctorate is faced with velvet and has three bars of the same material across the sleeves; the facing and bars can be either black, blue, or a color matching the field in which the degree is earned.

Hoods are lined with the colors of the school granting the degree. The velvet border of the hood indicates the discipline. The hood for the doctorate has distinguishing panels and is longer than that for the master's degree. Hoods are not usually worn for the bachelor's or associate degrees at UMGC. Bachelor's degree recipients who have earned honors for outstanding scholarship wear cords as part of their academic regalia—gold for *summa cum laude*, blue for *magna cum laude*, and white for *cum laude*. These honors are awarded to students at UMGC with a grade point average of 3.800 and higher.

The standard cap is the mortarboard, which is usually the same color as the gown. At UMGC, tassels worn by candidates for degrees below the doctoral level are worn on the right and are moved—with great fanfare to the left at the end of the ceremony.

The regalia worn by the university president is uniquely designed for each institution. Presidential robes have four bars of velvet across the sleeves, generally piped in a contrasting color, and may have velvet panels down the front. The UMGC president's gown is red with black velvet facing and gold piping to represent the university's colors.

ACADEMIC DEGREES

A DEGREE is awarded for successfully completing a course of study. U.S. colleges and universities now confer more than 1,600 types of academic degrees.

The first degree recorded in history was a doctorate conferred by the University of Bologna in the middle of the twelfth century. Originally, the doctor's and master's degrees were used interchangeably, each indicating that the holder was qualified to give instruction to students. The bachelor's, or baccalaureate, degree indicated only entrance upon a course of study preparatory to a doctorate or mastership. Gradually, however, the bachelor's degree came to signify the successful completion of a level of advanced study preparatory to the higher degrees.

The associate degree originated at the University of Chicago, which began awarding them in 1900. Today's associate degree is typically awarded after two years of study and is often composed of coursework that may be applied toward a bachelor's degree.

In North America, the Bachelor of Arts (BA) was first conferred in 1642, on the nine young men who constituted the first graduating class of Harvard College. Yale conferred its first Bachelor of Arts in 1702; Princeton, in 1748; William and Mary, in 1753; Pennsylvania, in 1757; and Columbia, in 1758. The Bachelor of Science (BS) was awarded to four graduates of Harvard's class of 1851; they were probably the first from any institution to receive that degree. Women in the United States first received baccalaureate degrees in 1841, when three women graduated from Oberlin College.

The master's degree has passed through various stages since its origin in the Middle Ages. During most of the first two centuries of U.S. collegiate history, the only master's degree awarded was the classic Master of Arts (MA). The University of Michigan offered the first Master of Science (MS) in 1858.

Throughout the nineteenth century, the Doctor of Philosophy (PhD) degree gained status in both Europe and North America. The first earned doctorates in the United States were awarded to three students at Yale in 1861. The Johns Hopkins University was founded for graduate studies in 1876, after which more universities developed doctoral programs in varied disciplines but with requirements similar to the PhD.
